



The Diversity Index, which measures the probability that two people from the same area will be from different race/ethnic groups, is 66.1 in the identified area, compared to 64.0 for the U.S. as a whole.

Currently, 44.4% of the 79,780 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 44.8%, renter occupied; and 10.8% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 55.6% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 33.1% are renter occupied; and 11.3% are vacant. In 2010, there were 75,578 housing units in the area - 48.0% owner occupied, 41.6% renter occupied, and 10.5% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 2.43%. Median home value in the area is \$165,529, compared to a median home value of \$207,344 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 1.86% annually to \$181,535.
